

## CHECKING IN YOUR CHILD

On your first visit you will be given a Family Registration Form at a Child Check-In Kiosk in the hallway. Each week thereafter, you will check in your child thru the kiosk with your phone number for their safety. You can also pre-register online to save time when you arrive!

## PICKING UP YOUR CHILD

When you come to pick up your child, please have your security tag visible. When picking your child up from class, please be sure to keep your tag visible for the check-out line. The FWC Kids team member will check your security tag and your child's name tag for a match before allowing you to leave with your child. A child will not be able to leave the room without the presentation of the security tag. In the event you lose your security tag, you will be asked to show proper identification before your child may leave with you. \*Please do not send anyone under the age of 14 to pick up your child.

## SICKNESS/ILLNESS POLICY

In order to maintain a high standard of health for our children and volunteers, we ask your cooperation with our health standards. We cannot administer any medication to your child. We cannot accept a child into class with any of the following symptoms:

**FEVER • COLD SYMPTOMS • PERSISTENT COUGH  
RUNNY NOSE WITH COLORED DISCHARGE • DIARRHEA • VOMITING  
RASH • OPEN SORES • PINK EYE • RINGWORM • LICE**

## saying goodbye

After you have completed the check-in process, a classroom team member will receive your little one and any bag/belongings they have. Please wave good-bye and depart the classroom. It is normal for little ones to cry when parents leave, this does not normally last long and separation becomes easier as you attend regularly. Our team members will try to create interest in a toy or activity and give assurance that you will return.

## snacks and feeding

Please instruct the lead teacher of any special requests regarding food and drink. Snacks and sippy cups from home will be offered. If you do not provide a snack we will provide one for you.

*Please Note: At check-in, there is an "Allergies & Special Needs" area to complete if needed. That info will appear on your child's name tag.*

## changing & nursing

Our male and female restrooms are equipped with changing tables in the handicap stall. Our women's restroom has a bench if you need a quiet area to sit with your child. Our nursing mother's room is located behind the Hub, beside the Preschool classroom (see an usher for assistance if needed). It's equipped with gliders for your comfort, and a changing station. Our service is also broadcasted should you need to tend to your baby while service is in progress. Only mother's feeding their children are permitted to the nursing mother's room; please no fathers, or siblings.
